

Good news, Fr. Kiko is adding one more mass starting this weekend, Sunday at 1 pm in Spanish. In accordance with Archbishop Sample and Governor Brown's executive orders, the number of people at a Mass cannot exceed 25. This includes the priest, essential ministers, musicians and anyone present. Appropriate social distancing minimum 6 feet, (except members of the same household) and adequate cleaning of the church after each use must be maintained.

Friday 10:30 am - 9 pm

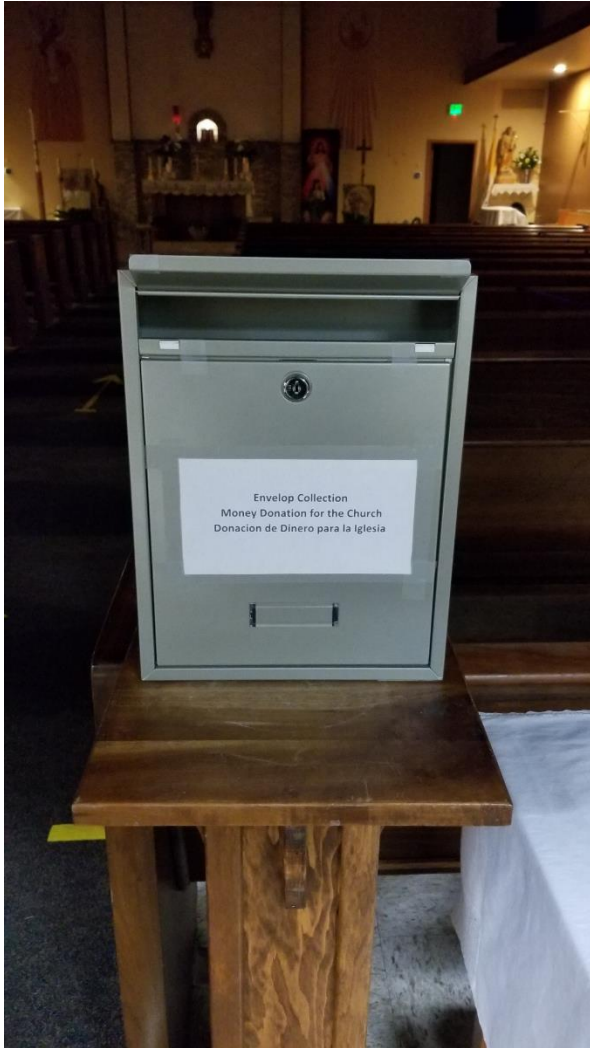

Anyone attending Mass or Adoration does so at their own risk. Vulnerable, at-risk and otherwise concerned persons should remain home. Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness must remain home.

The general dispensation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation continues. Fr. Kiko will continue to livestream his masses on Facebook (with the exception of the Sunday 1 pm mass, second Spanish Mass of the day).

Regular Confessions are from 3:30–4:30 pm on Saturday or by appointment with Fr. Kiko.

A record of the list of those who signed-up and attended each Mass must be maintained by the parish. In the event of a COVID positive case, the parish must assist public health officials with tracing and contacting everyone who may have been exposed.

Use of face masks/coverings is recommended by the CDC. Use of face masks/coverings at Masses is left to individual discretion. **Only those with masks can join in congregational singing.**

A single entrance will be used to come in to the Church. The ushers or someone else will be assigned to check you in. If you are not on the list you will not be able to attend.

Individuals/families will be allowed to attend Mass only once in a given period as determined by the parish. This may change, but for now we are saying once a month for weekend masses: once a week for weekday masses. As of 5 pm on Friday, we will fill any weekend open slots. The reason for this system is to allow everyone who wants to sign up, the opportunity for mass before the cycle repeats.

Starting in June there will be Celebration of the Sacraments on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings at 7 pm. **RCIA and RCIC candidates** will be scheduled four (4) to a mass from June 2nd -9th. Each candidate is allowed five (5) attendees including themselves. Typically would be the candidate, parents and grandparents, total of 5. Fr. Kiko will livestream on Facebook for family members and others to observe. RCIA and RCIC candidates should contact:
