Later, once the church begins, big equipment will be on the High Street entrance, so please be aware of the dumpster in the road for parking and backing up. Both stone/rock roofs are being removed and replaced with metal roofs. The architect is Jim Whitten of Austin and the contractor is Jon Riggs Construction. I will keep you informed as to dates, so we can minimize our movement while the work is going on. Thank you to all who have made this possible by years of donations and prayers.
NOTE: I will be on vacation this week and with the roof work, there will be no daily Masses and the office will be closed.
