The rock removal continues on the church this week, so I am asking we pause from moving around the building, to let the workers work, and for safety. Please be aware of the loose rocks and roofing nails (I've already found a few) as work continues. Both stone/rock roofs will be removed and replaced with metal roofs. The architect is Jim Whitten of Austin and the contractor is Jon Riggs Construction. I will keep you informed as to dates, so we can minimize our movement while the work is going on. Thank you to all who have made this possible by years of donations and prayers.
