COVID- 19 NEWS

The Bishop ended the bodily dispensation from the Sunday obligation on October 1, 2020. He encourages those still concerned about returning to make a good judgment for their individual/family health and safety as to return or not; especially those with underlying conditions, and those who feel they may have been exposed. I will update on any protocol changes for attendance as I get them. If you do come for Mass, remember to wear a mask (masks are available at entrance) and stay six feet apart. Hand sanitizer is throughout the church.

All Souls Day

This year the Mass for *All Souls Day* will be on Monday, November 2nd at 8:00 a.m. All the Souls of the faithful departed will be remembered on that day. It is not a holy day of obligation, but it is a great time to pray for our beloved dead. There will not be envelopes or names listed this year, but you may sign names of the dead throughout the month of November in the Book of the Dead in the church. The blessing of graves will follow Mass on November 2nd at Holy Cross and La Bahia that day. I will have the blessing printed and available at the entrance of church, so that as families go to the graves during this month, they may say it as they visit family graves.

The Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.
