

# LENT 2021

The Church designates Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as particular days of fasting and abstinence. All Catholics over age 18 and under 59 years are asked to take only one full meal on those days, while two other meatless meals are permitted, although they should not be equal in quantity to the main meal.

The Church asks that Catholics over the age of 14 abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

**Penance:** Wednesdays & Fridays 5:00-5:25 p.m.  
Saturday 5:00 - 5:45 p.m.

**Rice Bowl:** Sundays of Lent & Easter Sunday  
Basket will be at Church entrance

**Stations of the Cross:** Fridays of Lent  
following the 5:30 p.m. Mass in the Church.

And also, you have the opportunity to walk the Stations any day of the week, following the outdoor Stations of the Cross. Brochures are at station one at the Oak tree near the priest driveway and the stations end between the Church & rectory.

## The Very Reverend Gary W. Janak Named Auxiliary Bishop

Pope Francis has appointed the Very Reverend Gary W. Janak; who is Vicar General and Chancellor of the Diocese of Victoria and pastor of the Cathedral of Our Lady of Victory in Victoria, as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of San Antonio. He is the first priest ordained for the Diocese of Victoria in Texas to be consecrated a bishop. It will take place on April 20, 2021.
