

LENT 2021

The Church designates Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as particular days of fasting and abstinence. All Catholics over age 18 and under 59 years are asked to take only one full meal on those days, while two other meatless meals are permitted, although they should not be equal in quantity to the main meal.

The Church asks that Catholics over the age of 14 abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.
