

**L e c t o r s**

Just a few reminders:

- Read loud and clear, giving adequate pauses for the congregation to hear what is being proclaimed. Proclaim as though the person in the very back can't hear, has no text, is fumbling around in their purse, is cleaning their glasses, etc., and you want them to hear the reading and remember it.

- Do not make artificial accents or voices while reading, no humming.

- There are no instructions, either with hand or voice; such as please stand, your response, etc.

- Do not read anything written in red. Also do not say "The First Reading," "The Second Reading," "Responsorial Psalm," "The Response is." Simply start the reading as written: "A reading from ..." And that goes as well for the General Intercessions.

- With regard to the Responsorial Psalm: Please remember that except for the initial announcement of the Psalm Response, the response is said only by the congregation. For example, you simply begin by saying "The Lord is My Shepherd, there is nothing I shall want," then the congregation repeats from then on out. This allows you time to read the verse as they finish.

- If a ribbon is across the page, please move it to the book's center fold out of courtesy.

- Remember modesty in dress.

- If you assist in blowing out candles, please use the snuffer only; because blowing sends black soot, wick filament, some of which may still be on fire, and debris all over the altar cloth.
