**GENERAL POLICIES/ GUIDELINES Parish Religious Education** - In this Parish, religion classes begin in the 1st grade and classes are held each year until the Sacrament of Confirmation in the 10th grade. Kindergarten is optional.

Collaboration with Parents – Parents are the first teachers of their children in the faith. They are the primary educators of their children. Catechists assist the parents in their duties of teaching the faith, and thus communicate with parents throughout the school year in providing a strong foundation in Catholic doctrine and morals. The role of the parent is critical by attending weekly Sunday Mass with your children and in discussing and reviewing what your child is learning in class.

Commitment - It is expected that your child will be at all classes, unless prevented by sickness, emergency, or other personal reason. We do expect that you and your child will make the program a priority. In the event there are more than 3 absences the parents will be required to meet with the coordinator. Excessive absenteeism may result in the child having to repeat the grade in order to progress in the program, or for teens in the Confirmation program.
