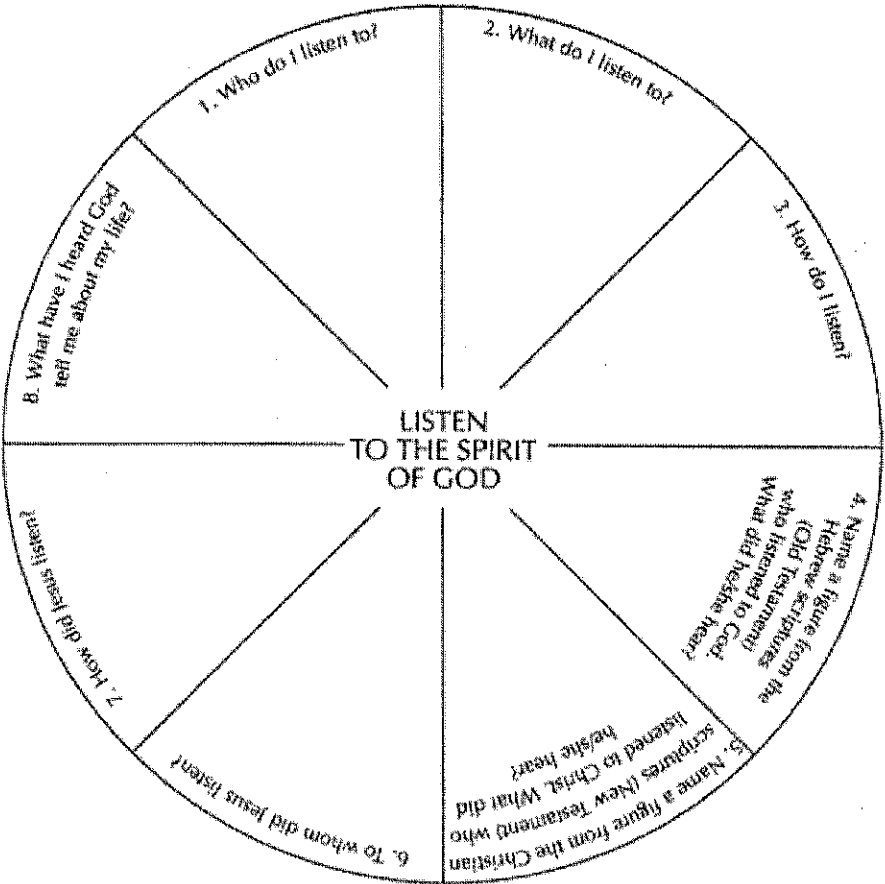

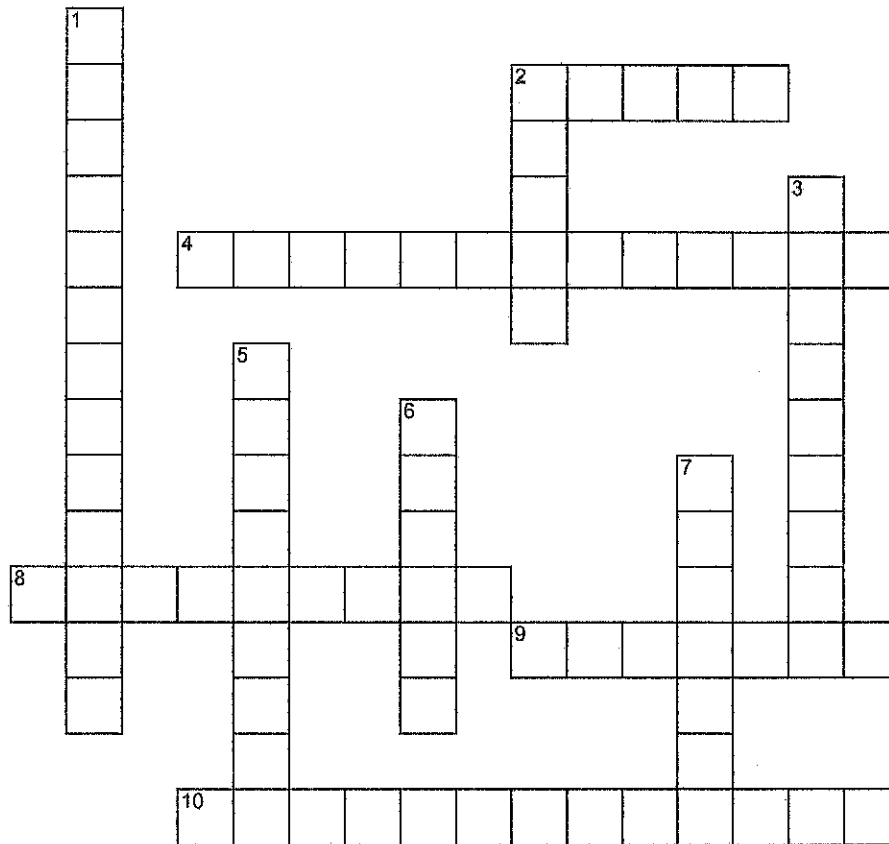

# Gifts of the Holy Spirit Crossword Puzzle



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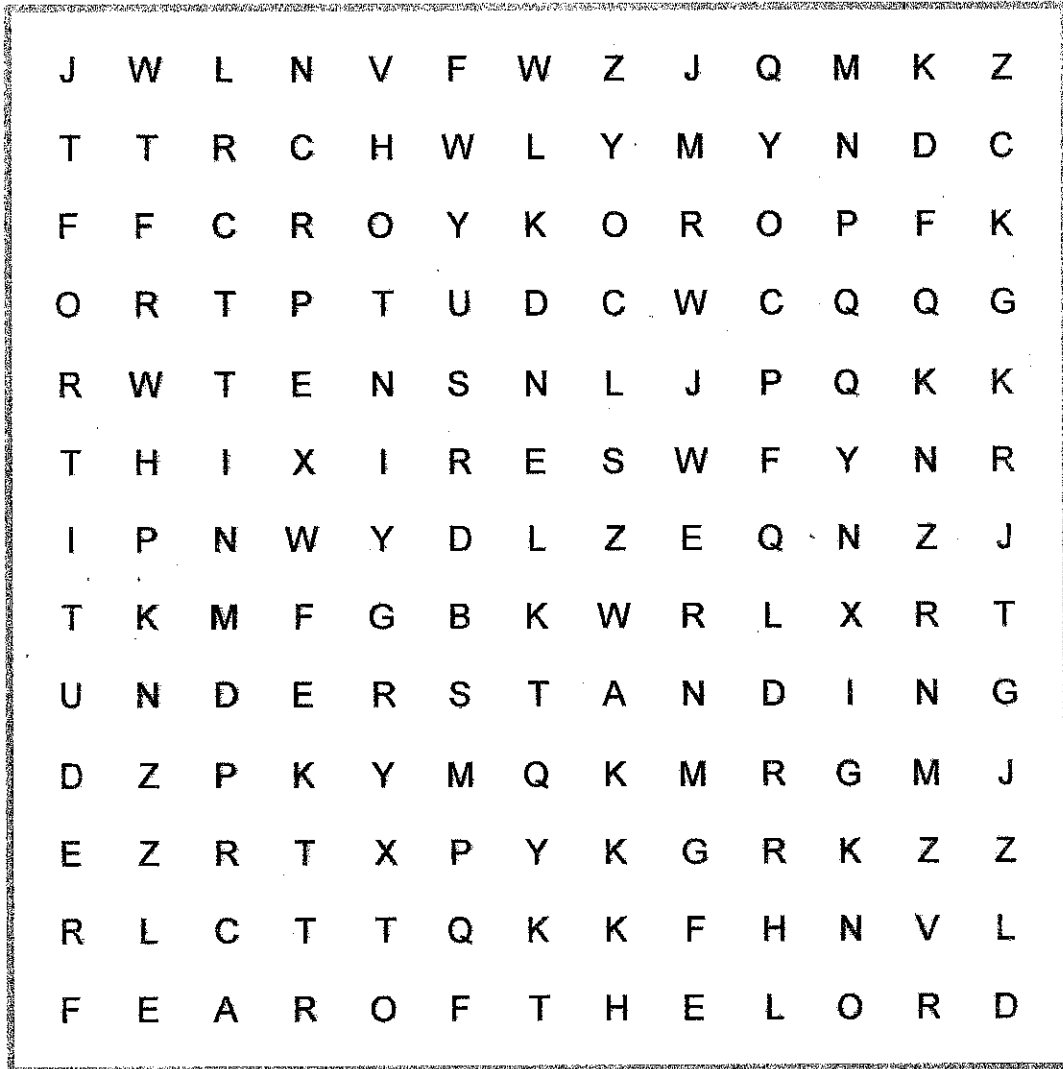
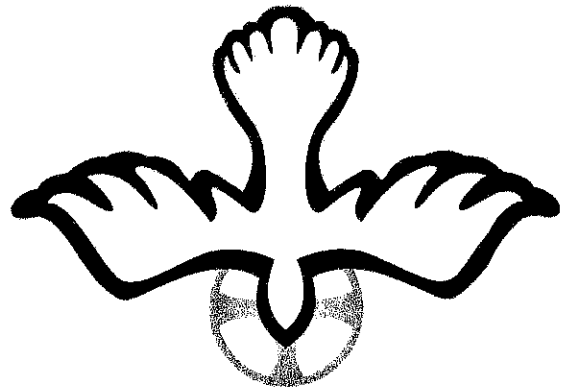
## ACROSS

## Year of Saint Joseph

**8 December 2020 to 8 December 2021**

To gain a Plenary Indulgence (one per day) for yourself or a soul in Purgatory, or to give to Our Blessed Mother Mary, you must:

- Receive Sacramental Confession
- Receive Eucharistic Communion
- Pray for the Pope's Intentions
- Complete one of the following acts:

1. Meditate at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer
2. Take part in a Spiritual Retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph
3. Perform a spiritual or corporal work of mercy
4. Recite the Holy Rosary as a family
5. Entrust your daily activity to the protection of St. Joseph
6. Invoke the intercession of St. Joseph for those who are seeking work can find dignifying work
7. Recite the Litany of St. Joseph for the persecuted Church *ad intra* and *ad extra*, and for the relief of all Christians suffering from all forms of persecution
8. Recite any legitimately approved prayer or act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, especially on 19 March, 1 May, the Feast of the Holy Family, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of every month, and every Wednesday.

\*\*\*This Plenary Indulgence is extended to the sick, the elderly, the dying, and those who legitimately are unable to leave their homes if:

- They are detached from any sin
- Have the intention of fulfilling, as soon as possible, the three usual conditions
- Recite an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, offering to God their pains and hardships
