THREE IN ONE

Although Jesus does command his followers to baptize in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19), the term "Trinity" is never appears in scripture. The Church believes that this truth has been revealed as the worshiping Church pondered its experience of God. It took three hundred years of such pondering before the Church declared the doctrine of the Trinity: the unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit as three persons in one divine Being. It is important to understand that "person" was traditionally understood as being in relationship to others. So the three persons of the Trinity are three in one: distinct, but one in being. As human beings in the likeness of our creator we cannot "go it alone" without dire consequences. We are all here to rely on one another, and find increasing joy in a faithful life.
