Rest In the Lord

For several weeks we have listened to readings that have recounted just how arduous the work of prophets and disciples can be. In today's Gospel, the Lord Jesus listens to the reports of those he had sent out "two by two" to minister to the people. On August 16 & 17, 2018, the Office of Faith Formation and the Catholic Education Center will host its first onsite Basic Certification at the Catholic Conference Center in Hickory. The two day training event will cover all ten hours needed to achieve Basic Certification.
