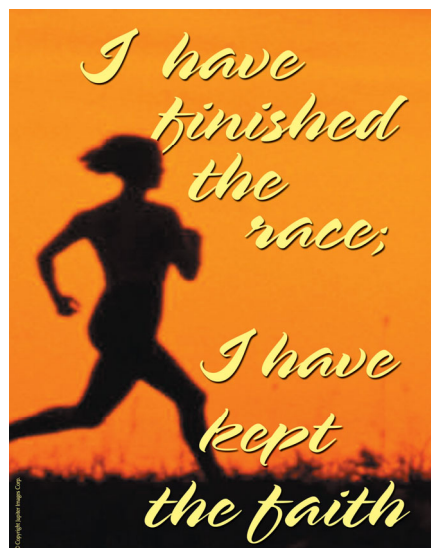
Marriage - Please contact Fr. Basile Sede at least 6 months before the desired wedding date.
