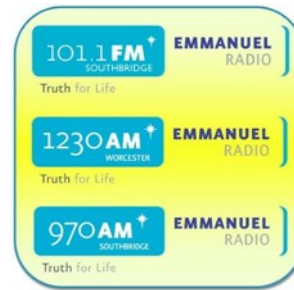

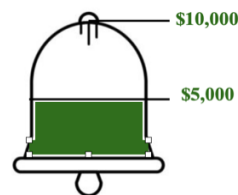

## What Should I Do for Lent?

**Maybe go Mass each day**, or even two days a week! Each day we have the 9am TV Mass in the chapel and the 12:10 Mass in the main Church. On Friday nights there's a 7:00pm Mass in Spanish in the main Church.

**Each day the Cathedral is open from 10am to 3:00pm so that you can come and pray.**

**Maybe stop by to adore the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.** The Lord is always present in the tabernacle and on Fridays you can pray before the exposed Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance on the altar. Exposition begins with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00pm and concludes with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:30pm.

**Maybe light a candle** and say a prayer at the Shrine of our Lady of Guadalupe.

**Maybe, in this year of Saint Joseph, say a prayer to Saint Joseph** for your family and for the Church. The statue of the spouse of the Mother of God is located near the tabernacle.

**Maybe pray the Stations of the Cross.** Free guides to praying the Stations of the Cross in English and Spanish can be found in the vestibule of the Church.

**Maybe pray before the Shrine of Divine Mercy.** It's located at the back of the Church to the right of the confessional.

**Maybe go to confession.** Confessions are heard after every 12:10pm Mass (weather permitting...that is, it's above 30 degrees and not snowing!) in English and on Saturday afternoons in Spanish at 4:30pm.

**Maybe volunteer to help in the Food Pantry.** Just call the office and we will tell you how!

**Maybe say a prayer at the Shrine to Saint Anthony** (next to Abby's House).

**Maybe say the Rosary** for someone who really needs it!

## ¿Qué debo hacer por la Cuaresma?

**¡Tal vez ir a misa todos los días, o incluso dos días a la semana!** Cada día tenemos la misa de tv de 9 a. m. en la capilla y la misa de las 12:10 en la Iglesia principal. Los viernes por la noche hay una misa de las 7:00 pm en español en la Iglesia principal.

**Todos los días la Catedral está abierta de 10am a 3:00pm para que puedas venir a orar.**

### **Tal vez pasen a adorar al Señor en el Santísimo**

**Sacramento.** El Señor está siempre presente en el tabernáculo y los viernes se puede orar ante el Santísimo Sacramento expuesto en la custodia en el altar. La exposición comienza con la Coronilla a la Divina Misericordia a las 3:00 pm y concluye con la Bendición del Santísimo Sacramento a las 6:30 pm.

**Tal vez encienda una vela** y orar en el Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe.

**Tal vez, en este año de San José, rezar a San José por su familia y por la Iglesia.** La estatua del cónyuge de la Madre de Dios se encuentra cerca del tabernáculo.

**Tal vez rezar las Estaciones de la Cruz.** Guías gratuitos para rezar las Estaciones de la Cruz en inglés y español se pueden encontrar en el vestíbulo de la Iglesia.

### **Tal vez orar ante el Santuario de la Divina**

**Misericordia.** Se encuentra en la parte trasera de la Iglesia a la derecha del confesionario.

**Tal vez ir a confesarse.** Las confesiones se escuchan después de cada Misa de las 12:10pm (Si el tiempo lo permite... es decir, si está por encima de 30 grados y no nevando!) en inglés y los sábados por la tarde en español a las 4:00-4:45pm.

**Tal vez como voluntario para ayudar en la despensa de alimentos** (Food Pantry). ¡Llame a la oficina y le diremos cómo!

**Tal vez rezar en el Santuario a San Antonio** (junto a la Casa de Abby).

**¡Quizás diga el Rosario** para alguien que realmente lo necesita!
