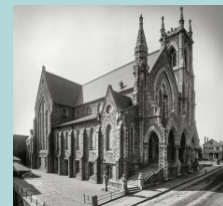

This Sunday's gospel (Mark 10: 35-45)

In today's Gospel, James and John ask to be given seats of honor when Jesus enters into his glory. Once again, the disciples seem to be selective in what they hear Jesus say.

They want to share Jesus' glory, but do not appear to understand that his glory will be preceded by his suffering. Jesus notes their lack of understanding and predicts the suffering they will endure for the sake of the Gospel. Jesus says that the honor they seek is not his to give. When the other ten hear what James and John have asked, Mark reports that they are indignant. Jesus takes the opportunity to teach them.

Jesus explains the importance of service and sacrifice in the life of a disciple. In particular, he seems to be preparing the Twelve for their leadership roles in the emerging Christian community. Echoing the Gospel we heard several weeks ago (on the Mark 9:33-37), Jesus acknowledges that his teaching is countercultural. In today's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the dynamics within the community of disciples with those shown by the rulers of the Gentiles.

Following Jesus' example of sacrificial love continues to be countercultural in our day as well. We might take this opportunity to consider our models of authority and examine our own exercise of authority. On whose example do we model our leadership?



El evangelio de este domingo (Marcos 10, 35-45)

En el evangelio de hoy, Santiago y Juan le piden al Señor darles un puesto de honor cuando esté en su gloria. Otra vez, parece que los discípulos solo prestan atención a lo que ellos quieren oír. Ellos quieren compartir la gloria de Jesús, pero no entienden que su gloria está precedida de su sufrimiento. Jesús les señala su falta de entendimiento y les predice el sufrimiento que deben enfrentar por causa del evangelio. Además les dice que el honor que ellos persiguen no le corresponde a él entregarlo. Cuando los otros diez escuchan lo que Santiago y Juan piden, el evangelista dice que se indignaron y Jesús aprovecha la oportunidad para enseñarles.

El Señor entonces explica la importancia del servicio y el sacrificio en la vida del discípulo. Particularmente, parece que Jesús los está preparando para el rol de liderazgo que tendrán en la comunidad cristiana naciente. Como un eco del evangelio que escuchamos algunas semanas atrás (Marcos 9, 33-37), Jesús reconoce que su enseñanza va en contra de lo que enseña en mundo. En el evangelio de hoy, el Señor hace un contraste entre la comunidad de los discípulos y las reglas de los gentiles.

Seguir el ejemplo de amor y sacrificio de Jesús sigue siendo remar contra la corriente de este mundo. Es necesario que aprovechemos esta oportunidad para reflexionar en los modelos de autoridad que seguimos y examinar nuestra conciencia en nuestro propio ejercicio de autoridad. ¿cómo ejercemos nuestra autoridad? ¿a quién imitamos?
