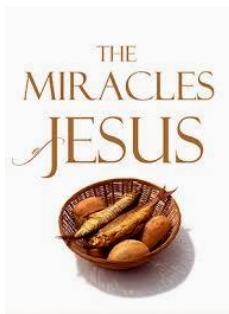
Many thanks to the parishioners who participated in the Forty Hours Devotion. The tremendous response and the many hours spent in front of the Blessed Sacrament made it a success!
