Saint John Vianney Parish will be holding a Forty Hours Devotion on Tuesday, June 18, Wednesday, June 19, Thursday, June 20, Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22, in preparation for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the annual celebration of the Catholic Church in thanksgiving for the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. This devotion developed in the 16th century in Italy and offers the opportunity to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for the Church and the world. The forty hours represent the time Christ's body spent in the tomb. Participation in Eucharistic Adoration is a worthy response to Christ's interrogation of his "You not watch with me one hour?"
