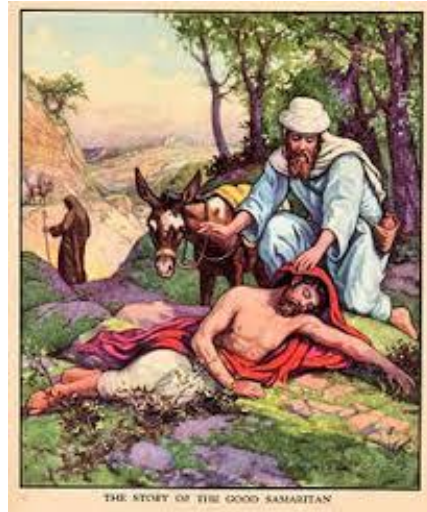

The class approaches morality with philosophical foundations and uncovers the foundations of catechetical teaching on our moral life in Christ. Attendees must be at least 16 years old or entering the eleventh grade in high school.
