The Church rejoices in their witness to the faith and seeks their prayers that all people may join them in the presence of God. **Mass will be celebrated at 8:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m.**

The second is **All Souls Day** on **Saturday, November 2**, in which the Church offers Mass for the repose of the souls in Purgatory. **Mass will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m.**

A **plenary indulgence** may be granted for a soul in **Purgatory** if one **visits a church on All Souls' Day and recites the Our Father and the Creed or visits a cemetery and prays for the departed on any day from November 1 to November 8**. The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence apply.
