### ANNOUNCEMENT FROM BISHOP SPALDING

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Nashville will be conducting a campaign study throughout the end of February, and Bishop Spalding would like to hear from you. The study will gather feedback on a potential diocesan-wide capital campaign. The campaign would raise funds to strengthen our parishes, support vocations, provide strategic growth initiatives for future churches and schools, and bring vital social services to those in need.

The Steier Group, a Catholic development fundraising firm, has been recruited to conduct the study. A final recommendation on the viability of the campaign will be made in early March. The study will provide everyone with an opportunity to share their thoughts through personal interviews, surveys, and other ways.
