Let's thank God for plentiful blessings, He has bestowed upon us as individual and communal.

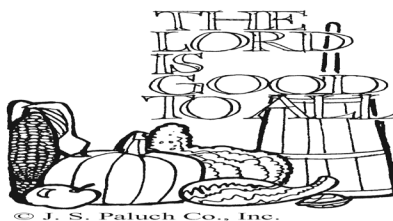

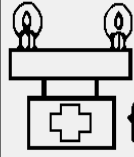


Sacramental Reminder
