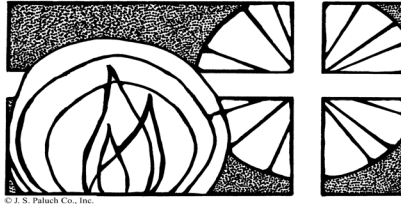

When they were unable to find lodging in Bethlehem, Joseph and Mary were forced to seek shelter in a stable, where the Christ Child was born. We will have "Las Posadas" in our Church, begin this **Sunday, December 15, at 7:00 PM.** All are invited.

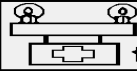
