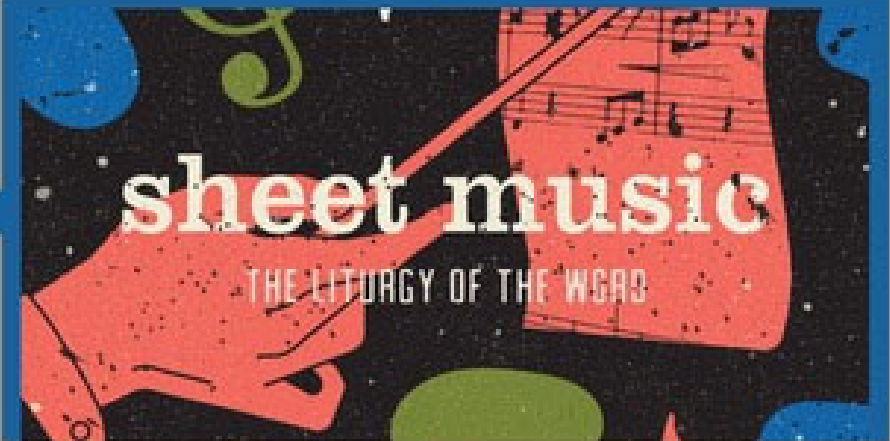
This week in YOUTH MINISTRY



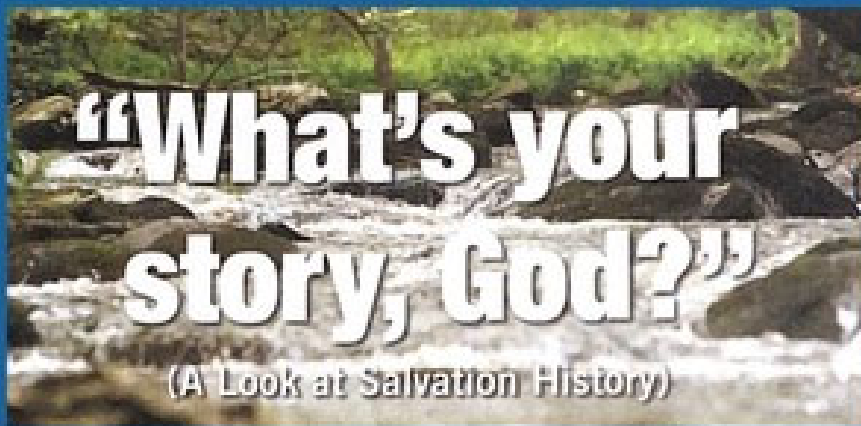
NOW AND FOREVER

The goal of this week's middle school Edge Night lesson is for middle school youth to experience the Mass as God's gift to us and see it as a place where God most fully pours out His grace on us. After the lesson, the youth will tour our church building and be challenged to visit the church more often.

The goal of this week's high school LifeTeen lesson, titled Sheet Music, is for teens to view the Mass readings as the source of truth that can lead to a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. After gathering for a fun game and diving into the lesson and discussions, the youth will be lead through a time of lectio divina with John 18:28-38.



This week Confirmation students will be introduced to an overview of salvation history. We begin by addressing the question, "How could a good God allow so much suffering and evil?" We explore the goodness of God's creation, how sin and evil entered the world, and God's redemptive plan (the "plot" of salvation history), which centered in the person and work of Christ and the establishment of the Church.
