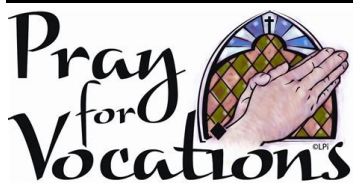

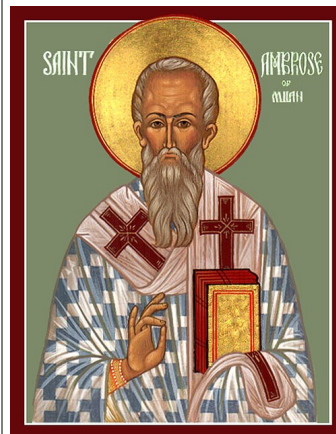
PLEASE say this prayer for all vocations!
