Sophia came to the United States from Honduras alone at age 12 to escape her unsafe environment and the gangs harassing her on her way to school. She was reunited with her mother shortly after her arrival in March 2016, and Catholic Charities began the long journey of applying for Special Immigrant Juvenile status. Now her deportation case has been closed, her green card application approved in July, and she can finish high school knowing her status in the United States is secure.
