This is not a complete list. The needs are endless!

- Computers—They are VERY expensive in Haiti
- Twin beds/mattresses
- Sheets & towels—any size
- Pillows, light weight blankets
- Treadle sewing machines, fabric, thread
- Tools
- Summer clothes—men's, women's, children, baby (No XL adult sizes)
- Men's dress clothes—business suits, dress shirts, ties
- Wedding dresses
- Shoes—new or gently used. Please wash before packing. Sandals, tennis shoes, flats, flip flops (no high heels or boots)
- Socks—new
- Underwear—new
- Hygiene items
- Hotel travel-sized shampoo, soap, lotion
- School supplies
- Large plastic buckets—cat litter buckets, 5 gallon pail
- Toys—new or gently used. Nothing with batteries.
- Bicycles—all sizes
- Children's ride on toys
- Kitchenwares (no electrical appliances)—table & chairs, dishes, towels, pots & pans, Tupperware
- Medical supplies (**NO medications**)—collapsible walkers, crutches, canes, wheel chairs, gauze, ointment, leg & foot braces, rolled bandages 2"-4" wide,
- Empty pill bottles—rinsed out, labels removed
- Religious items—priest vestments, crucifixes, etc.
- Christmas & Easter decorations—religious
- Office supplies/furniture
- Small household furniture
- Folding chairs or other small chairs
