

Homily Notes

Each Candidate will complete 30 weeks of Homily Notes during the Confirmation preparation process. These will be due in sets of 10 with set #1 to be turned into Mary Nowakowski or dropped off at the church office by January 12, 2020; set #2 is due on April 19, 2020 and should be turned in at your small group meeting; and set #3 due is due on September 13, 2020 and should be turned in at your small group meeting. These dates are also listed on the Confirmation calendar.

What are Homily Notes?

Homily Notes are notes taken during the homily at Mass. The aim is to get candidates thinking about what they hear at Mass and how they can apply what they hear to their everyday lives. The goal is to grow in discipleship.

What is expected?

In a small notebook, the candidate will write down the following for each of the Homily Note entries paying special attention to the questions in bold print:

- 1) The date of the Mass
- 2) Where was the Mass? (What church?)
- 3) Answer the following questions:
 - ❖ What was the Gospel about?
 - ❖ What was the homily about and who preached the homily?
 - ❖ **What struck you the most about the homily? (i.e. what stayed with you or got you thinking?)**
 - ❖ **How can you apply what you heard in your everyday life?**
