**Byzantine Catholic Community of St. Anastasia the Great-Martyr**

**NEWS!** Three weeks ago we visited a chapel just north of San Antonio in Schertz, TX (south of New Braunfels off of I-35). The chapel was not being used by the Archdiocese of San Antonio although it was somewhat maintained. The surprise was that the chapel (on 1 acre of land) had no toilet and no AC and no heat!! After speaking with members of the community, we decided to give it a go. After all we can purchase a mobile rolling AC unit and electric heaters and a movable toilet can also be brought in (even though there was an outhouse on the property). The historic chapel from 1905 was in a perfect location for our community and so we decided to move forward with leasing the site beginning Oct. 1. The Archdiocese of San Antonio surprised us when we began formulating the terms of the contract by including the adjacent 11 acres with a farm house with space and running water and facilities. We didn't even know they owned it! God willing next weekend we will sign the contract for the exclusive use of the property for a period of 5 years at \$1 a year! Through the generosity of the Archdiocese of San Antonio, we will be able to build up this community into a mission and parish with its own property very soon! With the help of God this will become the next parish of our Byzantine Catholic Church in Texas! I am now serving both St. John and St. Anastasia (which was begun some 6 years ago as a dependency of St. John's). For all of August and September, I will be going back and forth as both of our communities have Liturgy on Sunday. Starting Oct. 1, St Anastasia will become a Saturday community with Vigil Liturgy served in San Antonio (Schertz) on Saturdays and Sundays the Liturgy here at St. John.

SOCIAL HALL-The Social Hall will re-open on Sunday, August 26<sup>th</sup> as we rededicate the hall by blessing it with holy water after the 10am Divine Liturgy
