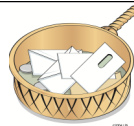

**Don't Miss These Symbolisms at Your Next Mass**

As Catholics who have gone to countless Masses, we know the order of the different parts of the Mass, and the responses to the priest's prompts come quite instinctively. But most Catholics might miss the symbolisms built in the liturgy because, well, we never knew they were there. Listed here are some of those symbols in words, objects, and gestures.

**1st in a Series**

**The Nave**

The nave is the large space in front of the altar where the congregations stays. The word *nave* comes from the Latin *navis* that means ship. The Church uses this word to describe itself metaphorically because she is like a ship that brings us safely from this world to the next—just as the Ark did for Noah and his family. If you are in a gothic church, look at the ceiling because its exposed beams look like the keel of a wooden ship for the same reason.

**How about making a Cursillo weekend?**

Cursillo or "short course in Christianity" is an uplifting and educational experience. Weekends are held at the Immaculate Conception Spiritual Renewal Center in Putnam, CT.
