### A Reflection of the Gospel from Living Liturgy

**2019:** In today's Gospel Jesus "resolutely determined" to make his way to Jerusalem, where the reader knows what fate awaits him there. Still, Jesus is not shy; he does not lack courage. Three examples of "would-be disciples" illustrate the point that there is no turning back for the life of a true disciple. The first would-be disciple is told that discipleship means a life of following, without even a place to rest one's head. The second has unfinished business, the burying of the dead; yet a life of discipleship still comes first. And the third wants to say good-bye, but here, too, a life of discipleship comes first. The image is stark. Once one puts their hand to the plow there is no turning back; there is no wistful glance at what was left behind. Instead, the disciples, like Jesus himself, must "set his face" toward Jerusalem and pursue that end with a single-minded devotion. This ideal may seem unattainable but is the call of the disciple nevertheless. Jesus himself sets the example.

Where do we set our face? What is our ultimate destiny? From what will we not look back to see what we have left behind? May we set our face toward our own Jerusalem and a journey with Christ, at the conclusion of which we will experience the paschal mystery. The journey is worthy of the effort. There is no turning back.
