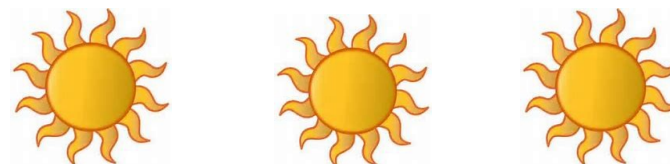

A Reflection of the Gospel from Living Liturgy

2019: Jesus continues on the road to Jerusalem by sending missionaries ahead of him to prepare the way. Much like John the Baptist at the beginning of Luke’s gospel, these seventy-two disciples are to proclaim, “The kingdom of God is at hand” and to call the people, communally and individually, to repentance. This account of the mission of the seventy-two reveals to us Jesus’ method in ministry. He calls others to help him in spreading the good news of God’s kingdom and he sends them to minister in pairs. The Christian mission is not to be undertaken as a solitary endeavor.

And the seventy-two are not specifically called disciples or apostle, though they are certainly sent. They go to the places Jesus intends to visit. We might ask ourselves who are the “seventy-two” today? And are we part of that large group sent to places where Jesus intends to visit? Just because we are not part of the Twelve does not mean we don’t have a mission. These seventy-two were critical to the ministry of Jesus. They prepared the way for him. In looking to a New Testament example of our call in life, there is something worthy of emulation here.
