I am all for celebrating the life of St. Valentine on February 14. I’m all for folks celebrating romantic love that day in an appropriate manner. At the same time, however, our parish family should welcome a unique celebration that date. See, February 14th is also the Feast of Ss Cyril and Methodius making that our parochial feast day. As means of celebrating the feast I have worked with several of our parishioners, and Kris to arrange 24 hours of Eucharistic adoration. I am grateful for their help.

The adoration will begin on Feb. 13 at 5:30 pm and will end on Feb. 14 at 5:30 pm with solemn benediction. There is a link to sign up for hours on the parish website, www.stcyrilchurch.com, under the “adoration” button on the home page. You may also sign up on the sheet in the vestibule today, and next Sunday. Even if you do not sign up for an hour, know you may come to the church at anytime to adore the Eucharistic presence of Jesus on these dates.

The adoration will take place in the small chapel. During the night hours the doors of the church will be locked, but please knock on the east door on the north end of the building and someone will let you in for schedule hours, or for an impromptu visit. There will be access to the bathrooms during the full 24 hr period.

As stated above, the adoration ends at 5:30 pm on Feb. 14. I’m not sure what any of you plan to do with your evening, but I’m likely going to head on over to the Happy Hour and enjoy a good meal to celebrate the saints who watch over this parish. I’d be honored to have some company.
