Practice of Faith

As we approach the end of the Easter season, today’s readings recall Christ’s suffering and address the feelings of abandonment that the disciples would experience between the crucifixion and Resurrection. Even as Christ prepared for his passion and death, he also prepared his disciples for his departure and, in his prayer, promised to sustain them. Our Easter faith assures us that we never face trials alone. Christ has promised to be with us always and surrounds us with a faith-filled community to support and journey with us. Reach out through a phone call, letter, or visit to someone who might be feeling isolated or alone. Reflect on your experiences of loneliness and the gift of community as you read this passage from Dorothy Day’s autobiography, *The Long Loneliness*: “We cannot love God unless we love each other, and to love we must know each other. We know him in the breaking of bread, and we are not alone any more. Pray in thanksgiving for the blessing of being part of the community of faith, the Church.”

Protocols for Resuming Public Masses Guidelines ordered by the Diocese of Amarillo

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is still in force and will remain until further notice.

Resuming public Mass will begin on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, with 50% of the capacity of the Church being able to participate.

The elderly, vulnerable, children under 7 years old and those who do not feel well are discouraged from attending Masses on weekends.

Provision:

Mass on Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. will be designated for elderly and vulnerable.

In addition we will add temporarily a 7 p.m. Mass on Thursdays.

The Blessed Sacrament on Fridays will be exposed for adoration from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Weekday Masses will continue in the regular schedule.

Church:

Face mask is required during Mass except during communion.

Communion with only of the body of Christ will be distributed in your hand. When you come forward, please follow the usher's direction.

Please maintain social distance at least 6 feet on church grounds.

Family member that live together can seat together in the Church.

Every other pew is closed in the Church.

In the Church blue line in the pews means family seating and X mark means individual/couple seating.

In the Gym pews are for families of 3 or more and chairs for individuals and couples.

The main entrance at the East is the only entrance.

The side doors at south and north will be only exits.

The principal doors of the school will be the only entrance and the side doors of the gym will be the only exits.

The Cry Room is closed.

No public restrooms.

People are encouraged to follow the instructions of the ushers.

No Holy Water will be at the founts or at the tank; people can bring water to the office for the priest to bless.

After each mass the pews of the Church will be disinfected.

There will be no offertory procession.

While social distance is observed no meetings or gathering of groups will be scheduled.

Vacation Bible School is cancelled.

Confirmations will be on Friday June 12th at 7 p.m.; Faith Formation office will contact you for more information.

First Communion will be on June 27 at 5:30 p.m. and 28th 9:30 a.m., 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. all in the Church. Faith Formation office will contact you for more information.

Sacraments of initiation will be celebrated on May 30th at 5:30 Vigil Mass Solemnity of Pentecost. Rehearsal for this celebration will be May 30th at 10 a.m.

We are having two Spanish Masses at the same time one in the Church one in the Gym, ushers will lead you at the parking lot where to go.

Protocolos para reanudar las masas públicas
Pautas ordenadas por la Diócesis de Amarillo

La dispensa de la obligación de asistir a misa sigue vigente y se mantendrá hasta nuevo aviso.

La reanudación la santa Misa con asistencia de los fieles comenzará el martes 19 de mayo de 2020, con el 50% de la capacidad de participación en la Iglesia.

Se recomienda que los ancianos, las personas vulnerables, los niños menores de 7 años y los que no se sienten bien no asistan a la Santa Misa los fines de semana.

Provisiones:

La Misa el miércoles de las 5:30 p.m. será designada para personas mayores y vulnerables.

Además agregaremos temporalmente una Misa los jueves a las 7 p.m.

El Santísimo Sacramento los viernes estará expuesto a la adoración de 9:00 a.m. a 2:00 p.m.

Las Misas entre semana continuarán en el horario regular.

Iglesia: Se requiere cubreboca boca durante la Misa, excepto durante la comunión.

La comunión será solo con el cuerpo de Cristo y se distribuirá en tu mano. Cuando se acerque, siga las instrucciones del acomodador/usher.

Mantenga una distancia social de al menos 6 pies en los terrenos de la iglesia.

Los miembros de la familia que viven juntos pueden sentarse juntos en la Iglesia.

Cada banca alternada en la Iglesia será suprimida.

La línea azul en las bancas de la Iglesia significa asientos para familias y la marca X significa asientos individuales/parejas.

En el gimnasio, las bancas son para familias de 3 o más y sillas para individuos y parejas.

La entrada principal de la Iglesia en el este es la única entrada.

Las puertas laterales sur y norte serán solo salidas.

la puerta principal de la escuela será la única puerta de entrada y las puertas del costado del gimnasio las de salida.

El cuarto de los niños está cerrado.

No hay baños públicos.

Se alienta a las personas a seguir las instrucciones de los acomodadores.

No habrá agua bendita en las fuentes o en el tanque; la gente puede traer agua a la oficina para que el sacerdote la bendiga.

Después de cada misa, las bancas de la Iglesia serán desinfectadas.

No habrá procesión de ofertorio.

Mientras se siga observando la distancia social, no se programarán reuniones de ningún grupo.

La escuela bíblica de vacaciones se ha cancelado.

Las confirmaciones serán el viernes 12 de junio a las 7 p.m. La oficina de Formación en la fe se comunicará con usted para obtener más información.

Las primeras comuniones serán el 27 de junio a las 5:30 p.m. y 28 a las 9:30 a.m., 12:00 p.m. y a las 2:00 p.m. Todo en la Iglesia. La oficina de Formación en la Fe se comunicará con usted para obtener más información.

Los sacramentos de iniciación se celebrarán el 30 de mayo a las 5:30. Misa de Vigilia de la Solemnidad de Pentecostés. El ensayo para esta celebración será el 30 de mayo a las 10 a.m.

Estaremos teniendo dos misas en español al mismo tiempo, una en la Iglesia y otra en el gimnasio de la escuela, los acomodadores le indicarán en el estacionamiento donde ir.
