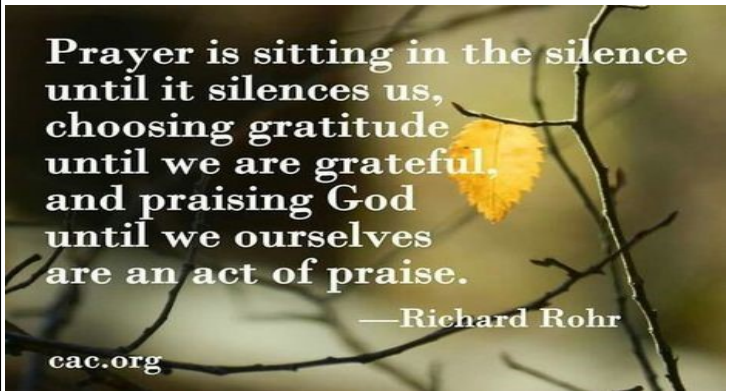

Practice of Charity

In today's Gospel, we are offered an example of intercessory prayer as the Canaanite woman is persistent and undeterred by challenges as she presents her daughter's need for healing to Jesus. Our prayer for others is both an act of faith and an expression of Christian charity. Notice the variety of circumstance in which you find yourself called to pray for others: Who are the people you lift up to God in prayer? In what ways have you known your prayers to be answered? Tell people that you are praying for them. Reflect on the variety of needs expressed as we pray the Universal Prayer, or Prayer of the Faithful, at Mass. Write your intercessory prayers on slips of paper or in a prayer journal as a visible sign of your prayer for others. Consider utilizing a prayer box, a box in which you put slips of paper on which you have written concerns or issues for which to pray.
