Practice of Hope

Like Jeremiah in today’s First Reading, or Peter in today’s Gospel, we sometimes resist God’s call and turn away from the full realization of the path of discipleship. To deny oneself, take up the cross, and follow Christ is not an easy path. And yet, as the psalmist prays, our souls thirst for God, who has planted this call deep within us and in whose service we find fullness of life. We follow Christ by taking up the cross each day in lives of service. Offer to Christ the daily sacrifices you make for others. Consider Christ’s call to take up the cross as you read Pope Francis’ words in The Joy of the Gospel: “Jesus wants us to touch human misery, to touch the suffering flesh of others. He hopes that we will...enter into the reality of other people’s lives and know the power of tenderness.” Ask God to strengthen your resolve to follow Christ as his disciple.

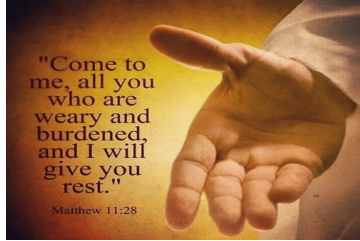
