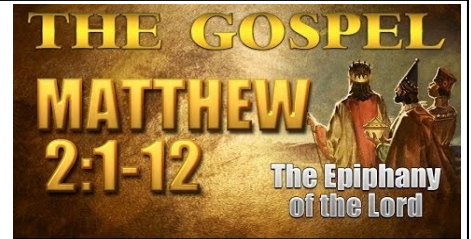

The Epiphany of the Lord



Gospel Matthew 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do homage." When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priest and the scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, and of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel."

Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

class.

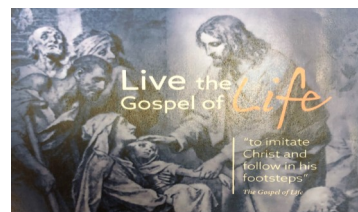


WALK FOR LIFE

Los niños no son admitidos a la clase porque distraen la sesion, por favor no los traiga.

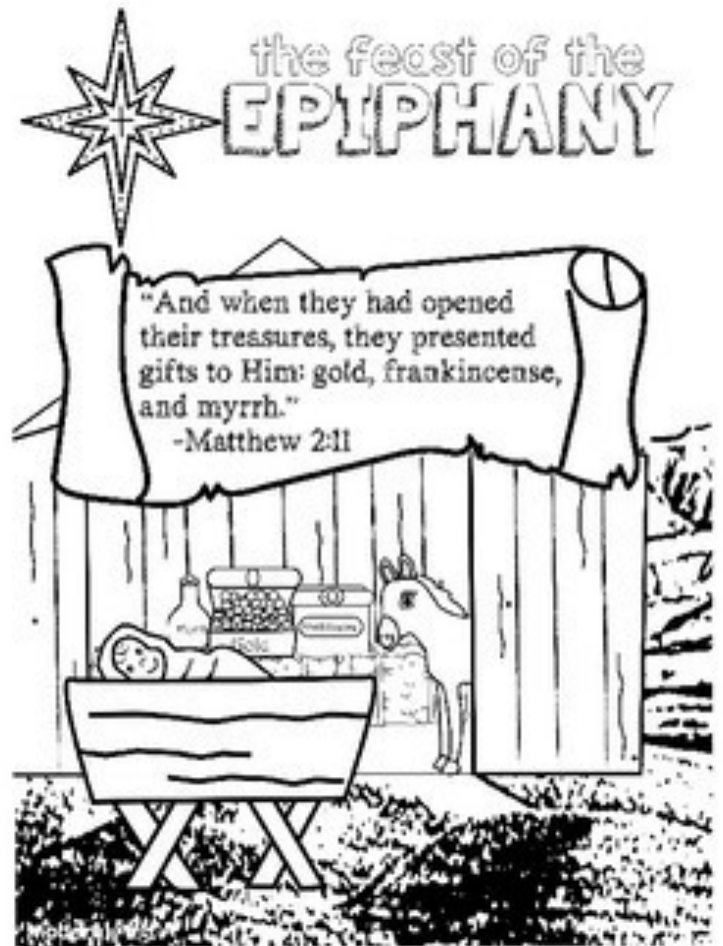


En movimiento

Sentimos un gozo inmenso porque Dios esta entre nosotros. Las lecturas del día de hoy traen a mi memoria los nacimientos que hacia mi abuela desde el primer día de las Posadas. Hacia nos nacimientos en grande, ocupaban casi la mitad de su sala. Revivo el aroma a heno y musgo, y miro los borreguitos, patos, pastores, arroyas, burros, pollos, puerquitos, pozos, y hasta leones y tigres en sus cuevas. Claro, que también estaban los tres reyes magos, bien distintos: Melchor en camello, Gaspar en caballo y Baltazar en elefante; uno trigueño, otro blanco y el tercero, mulato. Era el Día de los Santos Reyes!

Los tres mago solían aparecer de repente del otro lado del comedor, y cada día avanzaban un poquito. Ellos eran mi calendario de Adviento, Navidad y los demás. Finalmente, la víspera de los Santos Reyes, y como por arte de magia, bajaban de sus monturas y los encontrábamos arrodillados frente al Nino Jesús en el pesebre. Este era el día cuando la abuela nos daba Rosca de Reyes y nos explicaba, que también nosotros teníamos que encontrar al Nino Jesús. Todavía me impacta el movimiento de los Reyes Magos para poder encontrar Jesús. El Evangelio esta lleno de movimiento: los tres magos ven la estrella e inician su viaje; se detienen en el camino, se pierden, piden orientación y luego vuelven a encontrar la estrella otra vez, hasta que llegan a su destino: Jesús encarnado; entonces se dan cuenta de que Dios ha decidido vivir entre nosotros.

Hoy, me pregunto sobre el movimiento en nuestra propia vida. Que nos mueve? Hacia donde nos movemos? Estamos dispuestos a dejar todo aquellos que nos impide encontrarnos con Dios hecho carne?
