## **June 14<sup>th</sup> Bulletin**

June 8th was the second anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood! What an awesome adventure and privilege it has been to journey this last year with you all! On Monday I was able to pray this Mass setting for myself: “On the Anniversary of His Ordination”.

**Entrance antiphon;** “It was not you who chose me,” says the Lord, “but I who chose you, and appointed you to go out and bear fruit that will last.”

**The Collect;** Holy Father, who, by no merit of my own, chose me for communion, with the eternal priesthood of your Christ and for the ministry of your Church, grant that I may be an ardent yet gentle preacher of the Gospel and a faithful steward of your mysteries. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

**Prayer over the offerings:** We offer you the sacrifice of praise, O Lord, for the deepening of our service of you, so that what you have conferred on us, unworthy as we are, you may graciously bring to fulfillment, through Christ our Lord.

**Prayer After Communion;** For the glory of your name, O Lord, I have joyfully celebrated the mystery of faith to mark the anniversary of my priestly ordination so that I may be in truth what I have handled mystically in this sacrifice, through Christ our Lord.

These are the beautiful prayers for the priest on his anniversary. It is a day where the priest can celebrate the Mass for “himself” as the intention. As I look back, it is amazing to see all the people I have journeyed with become closer to the Most Holy Trinity in the short time I have been here. Some in the celebration of happy times, and some in sorrowful times. It has been said, “a priest is not his own.” I love being able to give myself to serve Jesus and His people. I can’t do the sacraments for myself. I still need another priest to anoint me or hear my confession. That is why I found the Mass prayers to be heartfelt! The Lord chose me for this mission and I need

His help to bring it to completion! The closing prayer is powerful, asking the Lord that I become like St. Paul when he said, “I have died and now the life I lead is Christ in me”!
