June 21st Bulletin

It has been a privilege to walk closer to Jesus Christ with all of you during this year: in parish life, in the celebration of the sacraments, especially the Most Holy Eucharist!

The Lord had me walk a sorrowful road with some of you at the passing of a loved one. Together in Jesus's resurrection, joy will win out; "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come."

One of my favorite memories of my time here is when we had a "gas leak" before the 10am Mass at Saint John Vianney. We ended up out at East Chain for Mass at 10:30. It was one of the first weekends I was here and Fr Beerman was over in Blue Earth for Mass so I had to make the call myself.

I enjoyed teaching the confirmation class in Blue Earth and was looking forward to celebrating confirmation with them but COVID-19 changed those plans.

The best trip was going to NCYC with youth over in Blue Earth! I am still moved with the graces and the level of encounter with Jesus that we all experienced together! We were able to pray over each other at one point, and I think we all cried over the blessing of the Father coming through each of us. The youth blessed the adults, the adults blessed the youth, and both blessed the priests. It was heartfelt!

The Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi was awesome!! It was my first Eucharistic procession; there were many graces that flowed out as we made our way around the block. We sang the praises of the Lord and listened to brothers and sisters pray Latin and English chant – it was so beautiful. There were cars slowing down to see what was going on; some people even stopped to adore! It was moving to have Jesus walk the sidewalks in Fairmont with his disciples surrounding Him. The witness of the truth of the Eucharist as the Real Presence of Jesus - Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity - was heavenly. Jesus walking with us through our lives is the biggest blessing the Father has given us.

Speaking of the Father, we are coming up on Father's Day. Happy Father's Day! Make sure you make time to thank your Heavenly Father for all he has given you!

SS Peter & Paul if you are planning on attending the daily or weekend Mass please note the following: According to the safety protocols of the diocese and the state of MN, there will be a sign-in sheet at the entrance of the social hall so we know who was attending. There are instructions on near that table to help explain the procedures. On the next table the hand sanitizer will be available to use when you enter and leave church. **Please remember to social distance. Families can sit together in a pew, but there needs to be 6 feet between occupants in all other pews.** The carport door will be the only open door at this time. It will be open from 8-5 each day.
