Extra Ordinary Eucharistic Minister

The title of my article is kind of a mouthful. What exactly does it mean? An ordinary minister of the Eucharist is a priest or a deacon. So an extra ordinary minister is anyone not in the clerical state. Which means they are your friends and neighbors. I believe extra ordinary Eucharistic ministers are extraordinary! These are people that give their time and talent for this very important ministry.

What time do they give up? I ask the ministers to show up a few minutes early to pray with all the other ministers who will be a part of Mass that day. We pray about 5 minutes before Mass. I would like this practice to be a regular routine at both church sites in the Western Catholic Community. The other time they give up is reflection time during the Communion Rite. I truly enjoy what I do, but I remember how nice it was to offer prayer after I receive the most precious Body and Blood. I thank these ministers for their commitment.

What sort of talent does this ministry of extra ordinary Eucharistic minister take? One needs to be very reverent. When they present the chalice or the host, they are helping to facilitate an act of holiness. A minister doesn't have to be perfect. They just have to be willing.

We are always on the lookout for more ministers. If you want to help out your community in this way, please come forward. This Church belongs to all of us and each and every one of us needs to do our fair share. On Monday, November 14th, there will be enrichment for all Eucharistic ministers at St. John School basement at 6:30 pm. There will be a blessing for new and returning volunteers. If you are interested in helping out, I would like you to contact me and plan on going to the enrichment session.
