

Not quite... He is always there, always present... I think we just sometimes forget to look. But luckily for us, He is like a patient parent waiting for their child to realize they need help.

We all need this base knowledge that *God*, our Father, *Jesus* our brother, and the *Holy Spirit*, our guide; are always ready, willing, and anxious to accompany us throughout our days. This is one of the most important truths we can share with our children, grandchildren, neighbors, and friends.

Jesus loves YOU, faults, sins, annoying habits, and all ~ he LOVES you! How can He not? He created you, He loved you into being. When those we love do things that drive us crazy... do we stop loving? 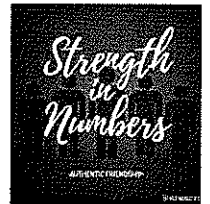

What is the Non-Public School Marathon
