I spent many years of my life just going through the motions, as far as my faith is concerned. I have to admit, I got really good at it. I went to Mass every weekend, I prayed (when I remembered), and I followed the ten commandments as best as I could. At some point I began to wonder, "Is this what being Catholic is all about?" Perhaps you can relate.

I'm sure you have heard by now, we are all being called to discipleship. Until recently, I never really knew what that meant. I certainly never felt I was "holy" enough to be called a disciple. But the truth is; we are ALL disciples of Jesus Christ. We are all on our own spiritual paths, which by the way, we will be on forever. So, how's it going for you?

I recently read an article that stated we don't learn about God to become theological encyclopedias. Rather, we learn and know, so we can be. We can be told to be more like Jesus all day long, but if we don't know Jesus, we really can't be like Him. I have made a conscious effort to include Jesus in my daily life. I started learning more about Jesus through reading the Bible, morning devotions, and Sunday evening book club. I have come to realize that having a REAL relationship with Jesus is not about using the "right" words or trying to live a perfect life. It's simply choosing to live a life that models Jesus' love.

So, let me ask you...how well do you know Jesus? If I can offer you an opportunity to get to know Him better, would you take it? From the Desk of Father Dave

I Will Let Fall a Shower of Roses

The rose may have been a favorite flower of St. Therese of Lisieux. Her feast day is October 1st and she is known the world over as the "little flower." Therese always wanted to be a saint. She said that if she gets to Heaven she will send down a shower of roses. Many miracles have been attributed to St. Therese's intercession. At times, there has been the appearance of roses, rose petals, or the smell of roses near where the miracles occurred.

Another reason St. Therese is so popular is because she wrote about a "little way." This simple approach makes it possible for anyone to go to Heaven. Therese wanted to spend her time in Heaven doing good things on earth. She learned in her monastery to live with difficult people and to reach out in prayer to the outside world. This living of the "little way" is so uncomplicated yet so profound that St. John Paul II made her a Doctor of the Church because of the way her theology touched people's lives.

She entered the Carmelite monastery when she was 15 and died when she was 24. Her writings mainly include her spiritual autobiography called the Story of a Soul. She was very sick when it was completed by the nuns in the same monastery. Therese died 120 years ago. Therese saw her vocation as love. Her chosen vocation helps to complete the rest of the vocations of the world.

When I was studying in the seminary, I was much inspired by her book. My seminary work was very rigorous and at times it felt almost impossible to complete my studies. After reading Story of a Soul, I found her "little way" most comforting. I used her intercession for many years after that. Many are influenced by this obscure French nun who is now known the world over because her way was simple and made a great deal of sense to people. I challenge you to read Story of a Soul or at least find out a little more about this small but powerful saint.

Sign Up for Rake-n-Run

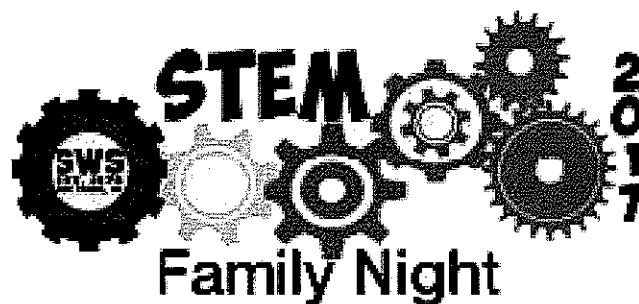

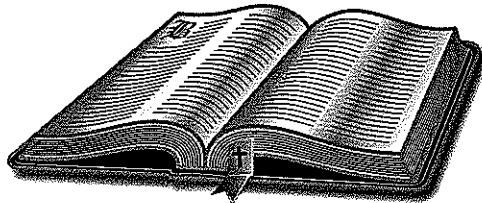
