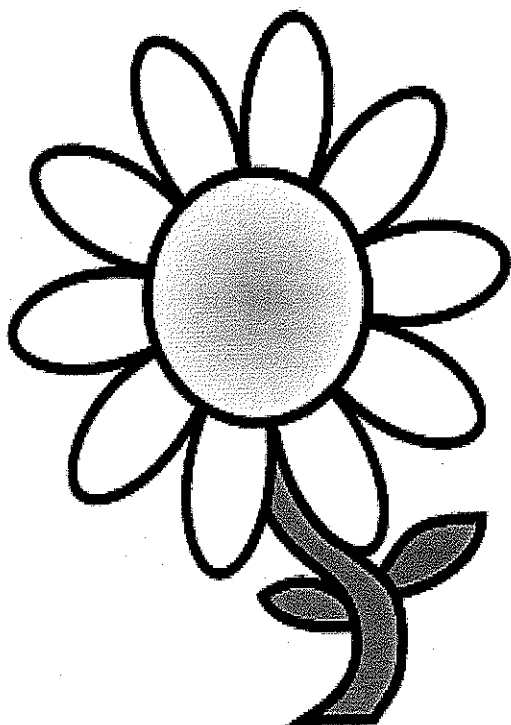

A Message Regarding Discipleship...

Fr. George told this joke in the sacristy last week while waiting for a funeral to begin: A Sunday school teacher asked her class, what big feast day did we just celebrate? "Easter!" exclaimed one eager child. And what happened at Easter? "Jesus rose from the dead," another student chimed in. "And then what happened?" the teacher continued. "Well," one child explained, "Jesus saw his shadow and hopped back in and we had six more weeks of winter!"

But really, then what happened?

The next big feast is Pentecost. These weeks between Easter and Pentecost seem like a time of expectancy and hope. The disciples were distraught and confused and afraid, hiding out in the upper room. Jesus appeared to them again and again and promised the Holy Spirit. "You will receive power," he told them. And so they did, in a rush of wind and fire, and the Church was born.

The Holy Spirit has been promised to us, too. We receive the Spirit at Baptism, we are taught, and at Confirmation in a special way. We may not experience wind and fire, but ANY time is a good time to ask for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit and a greater openness to the Spirit's work in us.

Each session of our Lenten discipleship groups opened with a prayer that began, "Come, Holy Spirit." Here is what one facilitator reported: *The verses, the discussion questions, the passage from Pope Francis were sent by the Spirit to our group. I can honestly say for myself and for the members of the group this was a life changing series. Everyone shared examples of how they have shared their faith with others over the last six weeks. I can tell you from week 1, no one was comfortable talking about their faith. The transformation was amazing. We also talked about the renewed energy we had in our faith...*

While the experience of each group was unique, the Holy Spirit is present in a special way when groups of believers gather and earnestly pray. Would you like to make your Pentecost special this year? Come to the Franciscan Retreat Center in Prior Lake the day before Pentecost, Saturday, May 19. It's an opportunity to reflect on your own faith journey in light of God's plan, to enjoy the beauty of the retreat grounds on a spring day, and to join your fellow parishioners in praying for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives and our faith community.

The day begins at 9 am and ends at 6 pm. A light breakfast, lunch, and dinner are included. The cost of the day is \$30. Space is limited so register early by calling the parish office.

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

From time to time, I will watch one of the many "ghost hunter" shows for a laugh. It is a lot like watching adults playing the kids' game, "Red Light, Green Light, hope to see a ghost tonight." Stumbling around in the dark with infrared cameras and all sorts of electronic gadgets, they seek to "document" that ghosts exist. The shows all boil down to someone saying to the empty darkness around them, "if there is someone here give me a sign."

Today we hear Luke's version of what happened on Easter Sunday. The two disciples, having encountered the Risen Lord on their way to Emmaus, return to the apostles hiding out in the upper room and tell them that Jesus is indeed risen! In dramatic fashion, Jesus suddenly appears in their midst, the apostles reacting like our television ghost hunters fearing they have encountered the ghost of Jesus. They do not have to ask for a "sign", as Jesus immediately bestows to them his peace. He then tells them to touch him and feel his flesh and bones. He eats some fish. What ghost can do this, he asks them.

Do we find ourselves, from time to time, asking for a "sign" from Jesus that he is indeed risen? Do we not wish that we had been in that upper room, touching the real flesh and bones of the Risen Lord, and seeing him eat with us? Every time we gather here on Sunday, we encounter the living flesh and bone of Jesus in the Body of Christ around us. The people we greet, those with whom we exchange a sign of peace are the real Body, flesh and blood of Jesus in our world. We see Jesus eat, as we watch those around us receive Holy Communion. We hear his voice as they sing and respond in prayer. In the eyes of those around us, we see Jesus look at us.

We don't need infrared cameras, special electronic gadgets, or digital recorders to document that Jesus is Risen and among us. The Risen Lord is alive and well and present in all those gathered around us every Sunday at Mass.

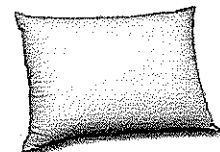

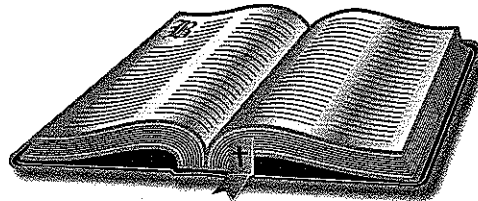

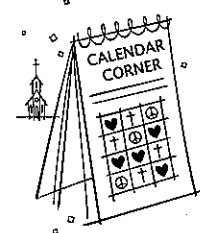
