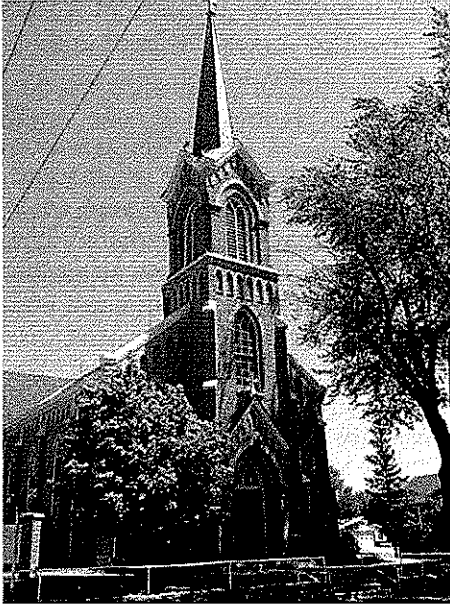

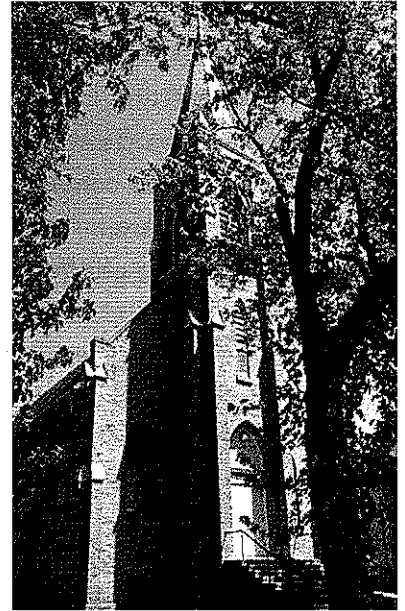

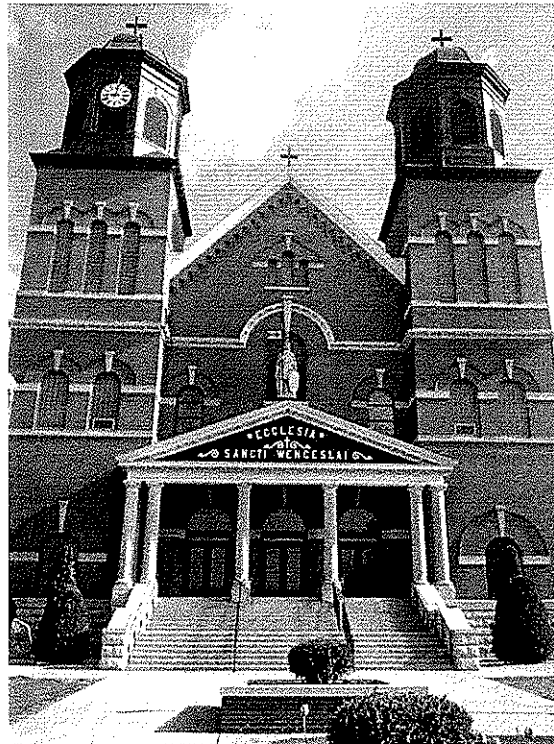

From the Desk of Father Kevin

One day, a youth asked to be a teacher's disciple. "You are not ready," the teacher responded. The youth persisted, however, and the teacher agreed. "I am going on a trip," the teacher stated, "You can accompany me. But when the journey is over you must answer this question, 'Who is greater, a master or a servant?'" The teacher continued, "On the journey there are two roles: one must lead and the other follow. Which role do you prefer?"

The youth responded, "It is appropriate that you be the leader." The two set out and that first evening, as they prepared their meal over a fire, it began to rain. The teacher immediately got up and held a covering over the disciple. The disciple was mortified, saying, "I should be doing this for you." "I command you to allow me to protect you," stated the teacher. Thus, the disciple relented.

The next day the disciple said, "Today let me be the leader and you can follow me." The teacher agreed. That evening, as they prepared their meal, the disciple said, "I will collect wood for the fire." "No," the teacher replied. "I shall collect it." "I command you to sit as I collect the wood," the disciple retorted. "No," again said the teacher, "It is not proper for a master to serve his disciple."

And so it went each day. No matter what role the teacher accepted, the disciple continued to be served upon. At the end of the journey the teacher asked the disciple, "Are you ready to answer my question?" "I am a bit confused," the disciple said. "In most cases the master is greater, but with you things are unclear." "Your confusion is healthy," the teacher said, "In society, the one who sits at table is greater than the one who waits on table. In the kingdom of God, the greatest is the one who provides caring service."

All of us must manifest the caring attitude that Jesus challenges us to exercise today. People are beset with all sorts of temptations that exalt the self, whether it be possessions, position, or opportunity. Catholic social teaching, while emphasizing the dignity of the individual, clearly articulates the need to use our skill, time, and possessions for the betterment of all. Jeremiah harshly criticized his contemporaries who exalted themselves while simultaneously damaging others. Jesus, in contrast, provided the perfect example of caring for others. The choice is always ours. How will you respond?

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

Jesus said to the apostles, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." In the gospel for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time, the apostles have returned from their missionary journey. Ministry saps a lot of physical and spiritual energy from a person. Jesus tells them to rest in God. His advice applies to all of us.

Our lives are filled to the brim with activities and distractions. Some of our busyness is by obligation and some is of our own making. In the movie, "Only You," an Italian businessman observes to an American the different approaches of Italians and Americans to work. He says to her, "We Italians work so that we can live. You Americans live so that you can work." Jesus is telling us the same thing. We need to take a rest from all the stuff we cram into every minute of our waking hours. We need to set aside time everyday to rest in God.

This statement of Jesus impacts our prayer life, too. Do we set aside time to pray to God? How much of that time is spent "yammering" at God? As ordained clergy, Fr. Kevin and I are obligated to pray the Liturgy of the Hours a minimum of 3 times a day. The Liturgy of the Hours is wonderful prayer, but it is extremely wordy, albeit those words are lovely. There are times when praying the Liturgy of the Hours is more work than resting in God. To rest in God means to rest from all the words; to shut up and just listen to the presence of God within us. This very ancient way of praying goes back to the prayer life of Jesus and the early Church. It has been called many things; meditation, contemplation, and, more recently, centering prayer.

There are many books and tapes about the practice of centering prayer. It requires as little as 5 minutes a day to 20 minutes a day. It is quieting oneself, focusing on a sacred name, like "Jesus", and resting in that sacred name. When thoughts flit into the mind, one just refocuses and continues resting on the sacred name and listening to God speak to us in the silence. Let us take to heart Jesus' words today and come away a while to rest in God.
