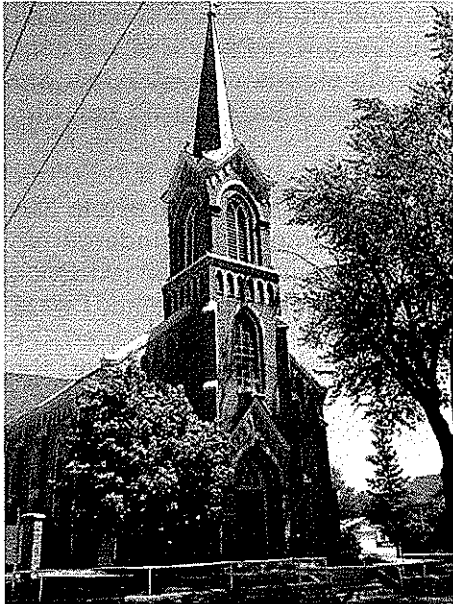

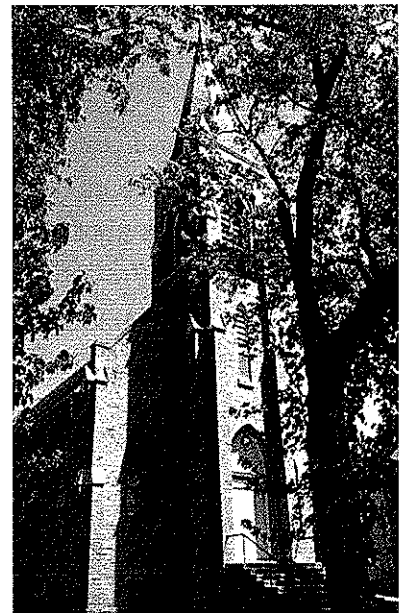

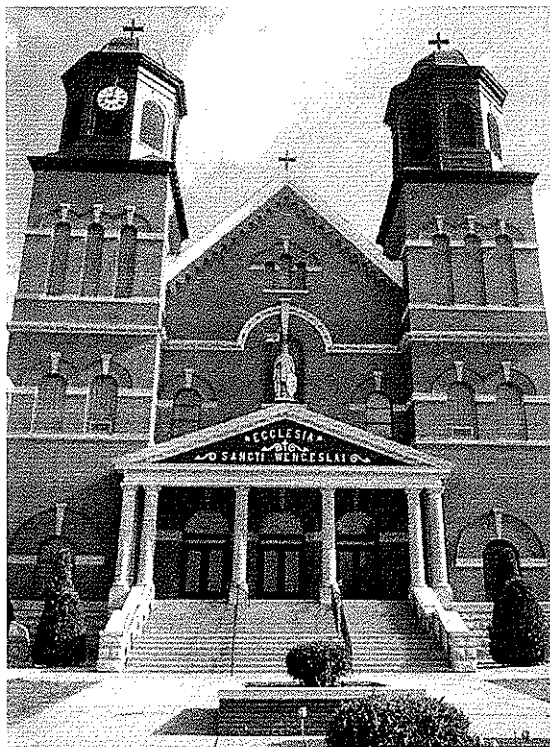

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

Have you ever heard someone called a "know-it-all"? Or have you, at some time or another, called someone a "know-it-all"? When I was kid, "know-it-alls" were people who thought they knew everything, but really were not all that smart. The character, Cliff Clavin, from the television comedy, "Cheers", is a good example of a know-it-all. Cliff mistook trivia for knowledge and would lecture people at the bar about all sorts of topics. However, there is a difference between trivia and knowledge. It is not enough to know facts. What is important is how a person applies that knowledge to life. A common cut used on the show was not to be "such a Clavin."

An example of this is in another television comedy, "The Big Bang Theory". When Leonard's car breaks down on the freeway, he asks his passengers, all with master and doctorate degrees in science, whether they have any knowledge of gas internal combustion engines. They all reply yes. He then asks them if they know how to fix an internal combustion engine. Dejectedly, they all reply, no. Like Cliff Clavin, they lacked the ability to apply the knowledge they have.

In the readings for today, we see an abundance of know-it-alls. Wisdom sets her table and invites all who are foolish to come and eat to forsake their foolishness and advance in understanding. St. Paul exhorts the Ephesian community to let go of the ignorance of their evil culture and to try to understand the will of the Lord. In the gospel, the community is unable to understand the depth of what Jesus is teaching. Their "intelligence" makes them incapable of grasping and understanding the depth of what Jesus is teaching.

We have two choices in life. We can either be know-it-alls, or we can trust in the wisdom and understanding of God. As the psalmist encourages us today, let us "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord."

Tour of Italy

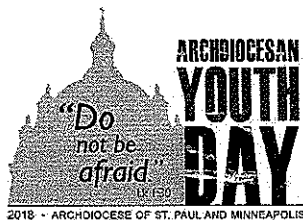

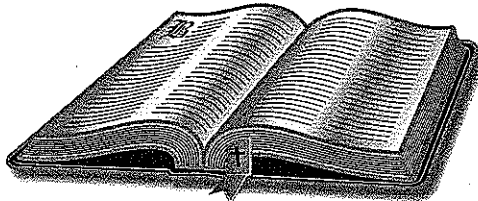

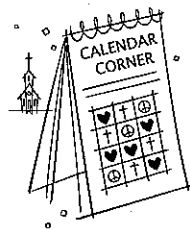
