**From the Desk of Father Eugene Theisen**



**Padre's Pen –  
 Morality vs. Values**

Looking around society and culture reveals that in many ways, we as a nation have given up the ghost on teaching morality. We have shifted to an emphasis on values instead of morality. Morality refers to the goodness or evil in human acts. Values refer to that which one judges to be important in life. Values can be (but aren't necessarily so) more subjective in nature while Morals are more evocative of objective standards.

The human being is a "moral agent." That is, we have freedom and rational decision-making ability. We are able to judge the goodness or evil of individual acts. This separates us from the beasts of the earth. This "freedom" is a great example of how we have moved in our country away from morality to values. We value freedom in our country. But it is often distorted into a freedom that isn't anchored in responsibility. It can be described as a freedom "from" something instead of a freedom "for" something. I am free from restraint to do or say what I want, when I want, however I want. The focus here is on the individual and what is considered good for themselves and their intention then on the action.

Freedom "for" something shifts the focus out of the individual to a standard or principle outside oneself. A belief in a God who created and ordered our universe supplies a purpose for our freedom and moves the standard for behavior outside the self. The morality of human acts then depends first on the object/nature of the action itself, then on the intention of the individual, and finally on the circumstances surrounding that action.

What I've just briefly sketched is the 3 items we need to consider for all our actions in a good examination of conscience. What is the action I have done? Is it of a serious nature or not? What did I intend in doing this action? Did I know the action itself was evil? What were the circumstances? Was I forced into this action?

What we should value is our Catholic Christian Morality. And when we put that into practice we can change culture and the world.

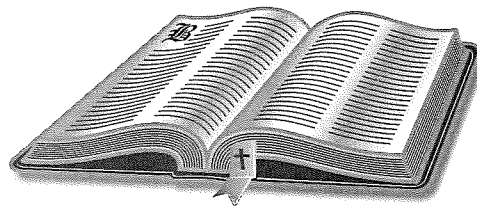

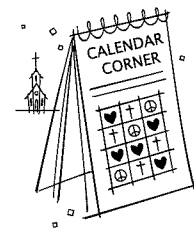
