Corpus Christi B

This weekend in Canada we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, Latin for "The Body of Christ". In most places in the world this feast is celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday, but in Canada we have moved it to this weekend in order to allow more people to participate in the celebration. The feast was first observed at the direction of Pope Urban the Third in the year 1264.

The scriptures speak of blood and the sacrifice of animals, truly foreign experiences for us. But we hear the following expressions in the Mass:

- the Lamb of God
- this is my Body; take and eat
- the Chalice of my Blood
- the blood of the covenant

What does all this primitive-sounding language have to do with us, modern people living in the computer age in a new millennium? How can we make it meaningful for the children who will follow us?
