

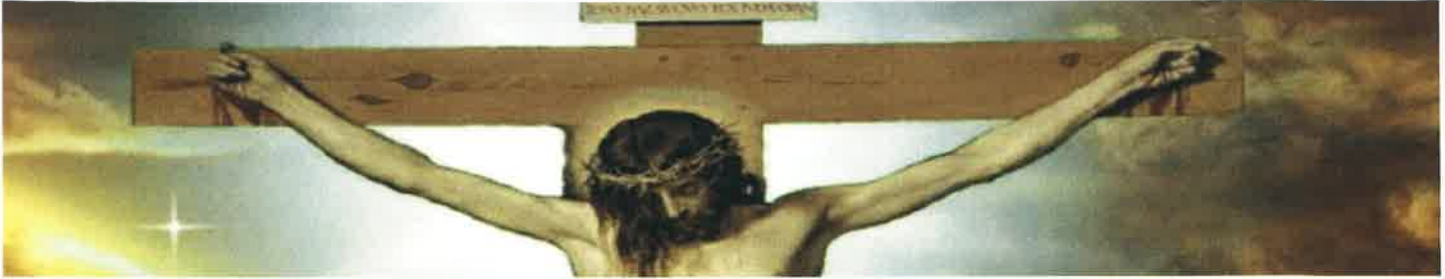

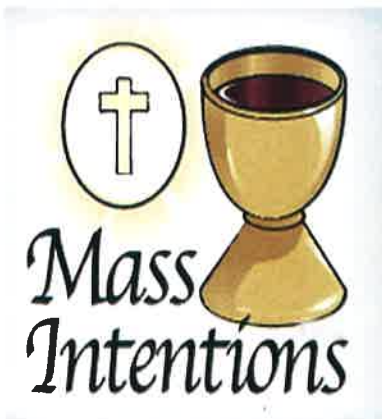

Last weekend we heard about prophecy. Today the readings move on to the mission, or **sending**, of the faithful. The prophet Amos runs into trouble in the city of Bethel, and to those who would like him to leave he points out that he has no qualifications for being there as a prophet, except that God has sent him. And Jesus instructs his apostles to go out, two by two, bringing the message of the kingdom; they are to take nothing but the barest of essentials with them, and to rely on the hospitality of those they meet and the power of the message Jesus has given them.

We too are sent out. We hear the words:

**"Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your lives"**

and we answer:

**"Thanks be to God".**

And in twos and threes, we go out to bring to the world what we have celebrated here. Are we indeed thankful for our mission, and dedicated to it?
