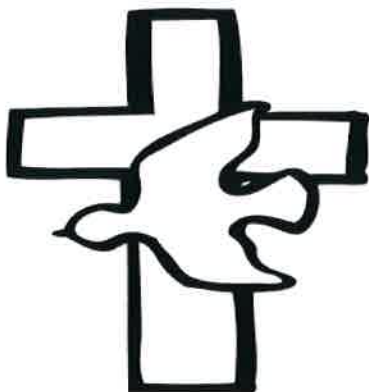
Attention all Grade 2 & 3 Students.....
