If any member of your family is sick at home or in the hospital, please call and let us know.

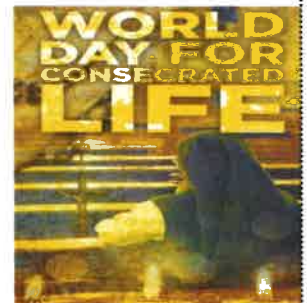
Welcome to St. Gregory's

Did you know that St. Gregory's Church is currently looking for a Music Coordinator....

Overview: The Music Coordinator's job is a paid position and a ministry in our parish. She/he should keep our parish music goals as a priority. She/he should work towards enhancing liturgical celebrations with music and song that inspires spiritual growth and community spirit.

Responsibilities

1. To organize music groups for weekly masses and special celebrations (ie. Christmas, Holy week, First Communion);
2. To help liturgical music when necessary;
3. To inform music groups about liturgical themes/seasons/special occasions;
4. To be aware of workshops, conferences, and training sessions and to encourage musicians'/singers' participation;
5. To lead discussions on the purchase of new hymn books or music for the parish;
6. To attend Parish Pastoral Council meetings and to pass pertinent information to music groups;
7. To collaborate with priest, musicians, singers and liturgy committee; and
8. To invite, call forth new musicians and singers.

Skills, Experience, Qualifications

- To have knowledge of liturgical music guidelines
- To have some background experience in music either as a musician or singer
- To have the people skills to be a positive support to the music ministry
- To have organizational skills
- To be flexible and open to suggestions
