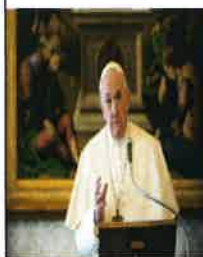

A saint is a title bestowed on a person who is remarkable in practicing all of the Christian virtues. They are deceased who, in the course of time, were a good example. As a result, they have reached and are living in heaven.



This title is conferred after exhaustive investigation of their good deeds. By the invocation of their prayers, we ask them to intercede to God for us on earth and be that strong aid to help us imitate their virtues.

Saints have been a part of our belief for many generations. While holiness may seem to be difficult to attain, the saints have made it, at least, a little easier to grasp. We see them as witnesses, examples of how to overcome our weaknesses.

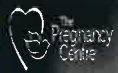


These canonized men and women have come from every walk of life and every kind of circumstance: rich and poor, learned and ignorant, people who have been tempted and those who have repented and people who

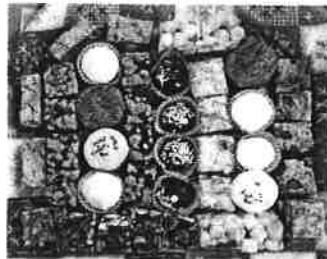
