

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

My dear Parishioners,

I do want to remind you of two important things. We no longer allow the rental of the Parish Hall for private use (funeral repasts, wedding receptions, baby showers, anniversaries or birthday celebrations). The reasons for this are threefold: 1) we do not have the personnel to monitor the facility during the event; 2) with the new, expensive and sophisticated kitchen equipment, we risk damage and mishandling of the equipment without proper supervision; 3) the Parish has grown and it is rare that there are days when the Parish is not using it. And if there is a day free, it is too hard having a 12 hour turnover for use the next day.

Another important issue I want to remind you of is the custom of reading eulogies and/or obituaries and/or poems and/or outside prayers at a funeral. Queen of Angels does not allow this. We have had this in place for several years now but from time to time people forget. I am glad that St. Landry Church has also recently put this in place for its funerals. If the Church is free, I will allow the body to be brought into the Church one hour before the time of the funeral for a Rosary and eulogy. But at 15 minutes before the time of the funeral, the coffin is closed and the Funeral Service/Mass begins. So, once the Mass begins, only the Priest or the Deacon speaks while members of the family may read the Readings from the approved list of Sacred Scripture and may bring up the gifts. Let me also remind you about music for funerals/weddings. You may choose to have someone other than the parish musicians do the funeral/wedding music, but because of the expensive organ and sound equipment you will have to pay a parish musician to be there anyway to monitor. Again, this has been in place for several years now and it protects our choir loft. Five years ago, non-parish musicians were here for a funeral and the result was \$3000.00 damage to the microphones upstairs.

Thank you for your kind attention in these matters. Please keep this handy for your files and please let your children know of these policies.
